

Release Notes 1.4

The following items have been moved (migrated) to Production for use by Agencies beginning on July 29, 2002.

- The following new security roles have been created and are now available for use in Production:
 - The *Management No Comp Emps* and *Management (VO) No Comp Emp* are the same as the *Management* roles, but access to the *Compensate Employees* menu path has been removed.
 - The *HR (VO) No Comp Emp or HHS* role is similar to the *HR* role with the following menu items removed: the *Compensate Employees* menu path and the *HHS* pages (*TEA* and *Retirement/Separation*).
 - A new role called *Query View-Only (EEO)* has been added to grant read-access for users to execute public queries. The ability to create queries is still retained by the PSC EHRP team. Note: No users in EHRP can access EEO data in public queries. This role is the first step in a phased release of security roles with different layers of query security.
- Access to the *Comp Summary Inquire* page has been removed for all users.
- *Recruit 52* printing capability has been added to all core roles except *Auto Actions Only* and *Position Management Processor*.
- A fix was applied for generating a printed SF 52 for Employees in a *Work In Progress* status.
- *PAR* remarks are now printing correctly on the SF50/52.
- A modification to a table was made to allow for Official names and titles (*POI*) to print on a SF 50 for a correction (002) action.
- *Citizenship* status is now required when hiring employees.
- The employee's *Work Period* field has been updated to 'Weekly' for employees in positions having a work period of 'Weekly'.
- A fix was moved to allow the *NTE* date for *LWOP/Furlough* on the *Expiration Dates* sub-page (accessed from *Employment 1*) to remain in the field.
 - **PROCESSING REMINDER:** Users still need to key the *NTE* date in both the *NTE* date field on the *Data Control* page and in the *Expiration Dates* sub-page.
- The *Savings Plan* page was modified so that the calculation used by the system to determine the maximum amount for contribution is now based on salary plus locality instead of just base salary.
- Code was changed to ensure that when employees are terminated through workflow, their status shows as terminated instead of active. The employee status codes of terminated employees have been updated to their correct values.
- Users are now able to save requisitions in *INI* without being prompted for the routes to next user.
- The salary table WG 017N for Dec. 2001 was loaded into production.
- Several modifications have been made to the *Online Help PoC Tool*.

- The date and time now appears next to the Date Opened field. This date is not modifiable and will provide an accurate tracking of the time the ticket was opened.
- The User ID field now shows the full name of the person entering the ticket as opposed to the login name.
- Status Date also will show the date and time. This will not be modifiable by the user but each time the status changes, a new date and time will be captured.
- The Last Updated field, which appears above the User ID field, shows the name of the person who last saved the ticket.
- When Advanced Search is selected, users can now enter a range of dates for the search criteria. Users will enter the Opened Date with a start date and the end date of the range in the To Opened Date field. For example users can search for all tickets opened between 7/1/02 and 7/15/02. Users also can search by the End User Impact on the Advanced Search.
- **PROCESSING REMINDER:** On the advanced search page, when searching for the individual who entered the ticket, you would need to enter the users login in the Operator field as opposed to the persons name.
